

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017

Cleveland Education and Training Centre will receive

**\$58,710\***

## This funding will be used to

- **Deliver targeted intensive reading support to all students with a priority focus on Pre-course and Course reading level students.**
  - Improve accuracy levels to their instructional level (90-95% reading accuracy).
  - Improve comprehension levels to a minimum satisfactory level (70%+ accuracy).
- **Deliver targeted intensive, comprehension reading support to all identified students with a comprehension score less than 70%.**
  - Improve comprehension levels to a minimum satisfactory level (70%+ accuracy).
- **'Close the Gap' between students in detention and students in mainstream school.**

## Our initiatives include

- Continuing to provide human and physical resources to increase initial PM Benchmark assessment by one level (minimum) every 3 months.
- Aligning the reading support staff to the new timetable to allow for focussed reading intervention sessions.
- Continuing to build the capacity of teachers and support staff to work with students who require targeted and intensive reading instruction.
- Enhancing the case management process and providing targeted feedback to teachers.
- Continuing to develop the volunteering partnership with the community.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Reviewing, implementing and embedding a whole school balanced Reading Plan with intensive guided reading intervention.
- Increasing Teacher aide time for one-on-one reading support. (\$40,000)
- Providing professional development, coaching and mentoring support to teachers in the explicit teaching of reading, utilising the gradual release model. (\$7,040)
- Providing a teacher allocation to support professional development, coaching, mentoring and feedback to support staff. (\$3,520)
  - Providing intensive guided reading practice, looking at the 4 levels of questioning.
- Purchasing resources to maximize success in the teaching of reading and students' reading outcomes. (\$2,870)
- Reviewing and tracking reading support through Case Management Meetings.
- Ensuring all students read purposefully within all curriculum learning areas every day.
- Continuing to provide Professional Development for volunteers in Support – A – Reader strategies. (\$5,280)
  - Introduce professional development opportunities to volunteer Youth Workers to support students in the Accommodation Units.
